

SUBJECT: Goad Road Transfer

WHEREAS a portion of County Road No. 987 (Goad Road) is located within and adjacent to the urban growth boundary of the City of Pendleton, and is in the process of being improved by the City of Pendleton;

WHEREAS pursuant to ORS 373.270, jurisdiction over a county road may be transferred to the city from the county when the county governing body deems it necessary, expedient, or for the best interest of the county to surrender jurisdiction over the county road, or a portion of it, within the corporate limits or urban growth boundary of any city, and the city governing body deems it necessary, expedient, or for the best interests of any city to acquire jurisdiction to the same extent as it has over other city public streets;

WHEREAS in accordance with ORS 373.270 (2)(a) on March 18, 2025, a notice of a public hearing, including the time and the place of hearing, and describing the road to be transferred, was posted for the jurisdictional transfer of a portion of Goad Road;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on April 16, 2025, in Room 130 of the Umatilla County Courthouse in Pendleton, Oregon, to hear public testimony both for and against the proposed jurisdiction transfer, and

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners finds it to be in the best interest of the County to surrender jurisdiction over the portion of County Road No. 987 to the City.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners orders the following:

- 1. In accordance with ORS 373.270(5)(a), jurisdiction of the portion of Goad Road (County Road No. 987) from its intersection with Highway 30 to its intersection with the northerly right of way line of Interstate 84, is offered to the City of Pendleton;
- 2. Upon acceptance by the City of Pendleton, improvement, construction and repair of the road by the County shall cease, and the transfer of jurisdiction to the City of Pendleton will be

full and absolute for all purposes of repair, construction, improvement, and the levying and collection of assessments.
