2024-2025 Supplemental Budgets

Scheduled for May 7, 2025

Seven Supplemental Budgets are scheduled for consideration on May 7, 2025. The orders under consideration are attached and referenced by order number for your convenience.

Budget Order 2025- 28 **General Fund – Elections**

The <u>General Fund – Elections Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$50,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$14,000, an increase in Capital Outlay of \$50,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$14,000.

Budget Order 2025-32 **Subcontracted Services**

The <u>Subcontracted Services Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in State Revenue of \$1,605,000, and an increase in Materials & Services of \$1,605,000

Budget Order 2025-49 **Justice Reinvestment**

The <u>Justice Reinvestment Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$15,000, an increase in State Revenue of \$55,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$70,000.

Budget Order 2025-50 **Emergency Management Grant**

The <u>Emergency Management Grant Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$10,000, an increase in Federal Revenue of \$17,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$92,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$65,000

Budget Order 2025-51 Jail

The <u>Jail Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in State Revenue of \$150,000, an increase in Capital Outlay of \$10,000 and an increase in Contingency of \$140,000.

Budget Order 2025-58 **Justice Reinvestment**

The <u>Justice Reinvestment Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$340,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$190,000 and an increase in Contingency of \$150,000.

Budget Order 2025-59 Victim's Conference

The <u>Victim's Conference Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$87,000, a decrease in Federal Revenue of \$55,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$87,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$55,000.
