## FIELD NOTES

For a tract of land in the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3, T.4N. R. 28 E, W. M.

Beginning at the N. E. Corner of said Section 3, which is a 1" Iron Pipe., I ran along the North line of the Section N. 89°-39' W. 280.5 feet to a nail at the centerline of the Old Oregon Trail Highway. This nail I had set previously in accordance with a Oregon Highway Department tie to the Section line. I replaced the nail with a 3/4" Iron pipe. I produced the line on N. 89°- 39' W. and placed Iron pipes as shown on the accompanying sketch. I reestablished the West right of way line of the highway by finding Right of Way monuments, one at Station 211/ 94.8 P.S. and one near the South line of County Road NO. 612.

I placed Iron Pipes and Iron Pins at all points of the tract.
