Matlick Field Notes

I began the survey at the East ½ corner of Section 10 T. 4 N. K. 28 E. W. M., which is a Ore. Highway Dept. bronze disk set in a steel receptacle box. Established line between this point and the N. E. Corner of said Section 10, which is a 5/8 iron Pin. Used Oregon Highway Dept. bearing of N.O°-21' E. for this line.

Found some Iron pins in the Campbell- Tiller Addition from which points I established the centerline of June Street. Brought this line to an intersection with the East line of the Section and checked the bearing of June Street.
