Surveyed June 1950 By V. R. Fraley Reg. # 183

I began the survey at the East ½ corner of Section 1, T. 4 N.

K. 28 E., W. M. From the mast line of the Section I turned an angle of 89°- 44° to the left and ran a distance of 665.72 feet where I found a l" Iron Pipe, which had apparently been set by others. As this point checked with my calculations,

I then ran on a bearing of S.0°-27° W. 1328.86 feet and set a 1/2° Iron rod for the S. W. Corner of the S. E. ½ of the N.E. ½ of the S. E. ½ of the said Section 1. Then in order to thoroughly check my work I continued on the South line of the Section and measured 664.87 feet S. 89°-20½ to the S. E. Corner of the Section, which is a 6° by 6° by 12° stone.

I layed off the 1 acre tract as shown on the accompanying sketch.
