
SECTION 32 T2S, R32E, W.M., UMATILLA COUNTY, OREGON



NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

This survey was performed at the request of Mr. Jeff Furnish. The purpose of the survey was to subdivide Section 32 as shown and to mark the property line shown as "posted line" (see the Legend) for repairing and rebuilding the fences on the propoerty line.

The majority of the corners for this survey were found and / or re-established by my prior survey for Mr. Furnish recorded as survey NO. 07-169-C. To complete the section subdivision, it was necessary to also have ties to the south quarter corner of the section. As noted in my earlier survey, the township line was originally established by David P. Thompson in 1864. That line was later superceded by U.S. Deputy Surveyor, George Pershin in 1882. I searched for both Pershin's and Thompson's monuments for the south 1/4 of Section 32 and was unable to find them.

The south quarter corner of Section 32 falls about 25 feet south of the creek at the toe of a steep north slope. There is evidence that this slope has been sluffing off toward the creek and there are also several ages of stumps from different logging efforts. It is my opinion that the quater corner was destroyed by this logging.

I re-established this quarter corner point by proportioning between the section corners to the east and west and then proceeded to subdivide the section as per the 1973 manual of instructions.
