Report Field notes & Plot of boundary  
Road from Wm Mitchell's place  
near Sheepner to Baldwells cabin  
in the Blue Mountains

To the Honorable County Court  
Wasilla County Oregon

We the undersigned viewers appointed by your body to view and lay out a road leading from Wm Mitchell's place near Sheepner to the Baldwin cabin in the Blue Mountains, would respectfully submit that in our judgement the road should be granted. Much of the road has been already worked and some expensive grading done, so that the road is now in use, and can be opened and kept in repair at comparatively small cost. The road is located on very good ground, and seems to be the general outlet into the mountains for the neighborhoods in this vicinity of Sheepner. Most Respectfully
