To the Leon County Court for Umatilla County Oregon
We the undersigned have been appointed by your
Court body to view out and survey a County Road in
the above named County and State would respectfully
report that we met at the time and place appointed
and after being qualified according to law by Alex
L. Coffey left County Surveyor called to our aid
G. B. Ward as Axeman and Alfred Blue and James
Means as chairman we proceeded to view out said
road commencing at a point at Alfred Blues Ranch
thence running North Westerly down the East Fork
of West Birch Creek two miles and 33 chains to where
we leave the creek and pass over the hill and intersect
the County Road leading from Pilot Rock to Beasleys
Mill near the school house we would further report
the road a practicable one and much needed and
recommend that the petition for the same be granted

Tree 6 inches in diameter bears N 56° W distance 96 Lks
and a Balm tree 8 inches in diameter bears N 29° W
distance 3 ch 24 lks each of the bearing trees marked with
the letters R & T from said post we run
N 8° E 45° angle thence
