

Report of Views, Field Notes, & Plan of Road
from Clark's Canyon by the way of E. O'Farrenworth's
field and Gilliam Ranch to the South Line of Umatilla
County.

To the Hon. County Court for Umatilla County, Oregon.
Be it known that the undersigned having been appointed by your
Hon. Body to view out and survey a County Road in the
above named County, and State would respectfully report that
we met at this time and place appointed and after
being qualified according to law by A. L. Coffey of
Court, Surveyor we called to our aid E. Miner meas-
urer and Richard Junkin and J. W. Brock as chairman
we proceeded to view out said road commencing at
a point where Clarke's Canyon intersects the road lead-
ing from Heppner to Rhea Creek and then in a
shutted course by the way of Gilliam Ranch to the
road leading from Leonidde Bridge on John Day's
River to the North Fork of John Day river, at being
the County Line of Umatilla & Wasco Cos.

We would further report the Road is a practical
one and much needed and can be easily opened and
kept in repair. We therefore would recommend that
the petition for said Road be granted.
