Report of Viewers. Field Notes and Plat of Survey of a change in a County Road known as the road from the 23rd mile stake at Pendleton,

To Hon County Court, Umatilla County, Or.

Gentlemen, we the undersigned viewers appointed to view and report upon the proposed change in County road leading from the 23rd mile stake to Pendleton, met as per order on the 18th day of April 1884 and after being duly qualified by JH Raley Surveyor, called to our assistance C. B. Wade and Frank Rayburn as Chairmen and after having them qualified in the manner prescribed by law entered upon our duties. We find said change as petitioned for to be a much needed change and one of great benefit to the petitioners. We believe that the route of the proposed change is equally as good and near as the present road and that no one will be injured by said change.

We therefore recommend the adoption of said change and the vacation of the present road affected thereby, as indicated in the accompanying plat and notes of the Surveyor.

Field Notes

at intersection of Main & Jackson Streets in Switzler's Addition to town of Pendleton, set Basalt Rock 6x8x4 - marked R. for initial point from which I run West 31 chains along center of Jackson Street, intersect line and set "A" Post. Run South 45 links to S. W. cor of S. E 4 of Sec 3 - 2 N 32 E. From which I run line between 34 1/2 West 12.50 and set "A" Post. Run South 30° W. 6 to intersection of Old Road and set Basalt Rock 6x8x4 marked R for terminus. Whole length of road 49.95 chains, as indicated by the accompanying plat.
