Report of Viewers. Field Notes and Plat of Survey of a change in County Road on the lands of Geo D. Peebler, G. F. Kimmery and Wm Estes on Stage Gulch Road

## Report of Viewers

To the Hon. County Court, Umatilla County, Oregon.

We the undersigned viewers in charge in County Road prayed for by G. F. Kimmery, George D. Peebler and Wm Estes, numbered 283 would respectfully report that we met with the County Surveyor at the time and place appointed by your Hon. body and proceeded to view out and survey said road as prayed for by said petitioners. We find the said surveyed change in road to be some longer than that portion of the old road to be a nullity by the said change is upon somewhat better ground, that in our opinion travelers would much prefer the change as proposed & surveyed, the said change in road is now already opened, worked and traveled. For these said reasons we would recommend that the said change be granted.

## Field Notes of Road Survey No 283.

Met viewers at time and place appointed and calling Sam A. Crowell and Geo D. Peebler to act as chainbearers and Geo F. Kimmery as marker, who were each qualified according to law.

I commenced at crossing of roads at  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. cor between Secs 7 & 8 in T. 3

N. R. 31 E. W. M. Set initial post in mound about 2 rods

chains D. E. and run thence north ea.  $22^{\circ} E$

40.45 along traveled road in lane. To initial post in Road No 2 26, about 30 feet. at Mt P. School House.

47.00 Set angle stake against fence, 45 links west of line - Cut A on E. side of fence post. and turn along road in lane,

$565^{\circ} 00' E$  80.00 Set 1 mile post against wire fence on N. side of lane

54.95 Intersect line running N. & S. through center Sec. 8 T. 3 N. R. 31 E. W.  
In at Res of Geo D. Peebler, turn thence

South 64.50 along traveled road to  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. cor bet Secs 8 & 17 in said Sp.

78.50 Intersect old County road - course N. W. Set terminus against wire fence, 45 links west of line. The posts are all of size and marked and set in mounds as required by law. The road is already opened and in good condition for travel and is a much better road than the old, although about 40 chains longer.

I hereby certify the foregoing field notes of the survey of Road change No 283 to be correct.
