Report of Viewers, Field Notes & Plat of Survey of a County Road Commencing at S.W. Cor. N W⁴ Sec. 5 T. 2 N. R. 30 E. running North Westerly & South Westerly Vending at Road known as the Thos' Ayres Road on Butter Creek.

Alkali Canon May 2nd 1889

To the Hon. County Court

Umatilla County, Oregon.

We, the undersigned, your viewers on Road No 326 would respectfully report that we met with John C. Arnold, Esq. Surveyor at the time & place appointed for the same, & were qualified as directed by law, we then procured suitable assistance & proceeded to view out the survey said said Road as prayed for in the petition, as near as, in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense. After surveying the Road along the East side of Speirs Canon, as specified in Petition, we found that the cost necessary to build the road would be more than could be met by the petitioners; & since the said Road 326 is, in our opinion of great need, we called Joseph Klein, owner of the land on the West side of Speir canon & adjacent the line of said Road as petitioned for, who, when he saw that the Road would not otherwise be made consented to allow the Road to be surveyed on the West side of said Canon, a thing which he would not consent to do with the petitioners for said Road, or this route would have been specified in the petition. We therefore took up the Road as surveyed on the East side of Canon & located the same upon much better ground & many less angles on the West side of the Canon as described. We kept as close to the line petitioned for as would give us a good Road, & recommend that said Road be located on the survey made under our viewing as the same is approved by all parties concerned.

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I meet Wm Rector & Carl Ellmer, viewers on Road No. 326 for Umatilla County, Or. at Nolin, Sat. April 27th 1889. 1st P.M. & administer Road Viewers Oath to each. It is ascertained that the point of commencing, to-wit: the $\frac{1}{4}$ S. Cor. on E. bdy of Sec. 6. T. 2 N. R. 30 E. has been dug away in grading R. R. & its true position, no one is able to point, & the center of said Sec. 6 is not definitely determined; I am requested to find these two points.

Jno. L. Reynolds & U. A. Ward are called & sworn to carry chain, & Elias Neel sworn to carry flag. Assisted by the above named persons, I am
