Report of Viewers, field notes and plat of Survey of County Road No 339 commencing and intersecting the County road leading from Felix to Gold Spring location at the NE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 4 T 5 N R 33 E.W.M. thence running Northerly on the line between the West $\frac{1}{2}$ and the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec 4 T 5 N R 33 to the Township line between Townships 4 & 5 and at the NE corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 4. thence East on the Township line about 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods to the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 33 T 5 N R 33 E. thence Northerly on the line between the West $\frac{1}{2}$ and the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec 33 T 5 N R 33 E.W.M. and intersecting County road at the NE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 28 T 5 N R 33 E.W.M.

We the undersigned viewers on road No 339 for Marion County do would respectfully report that we met Gno Arnold Surveyor, at time and place appointed for the same and were each duly qualified according to law, we called to our aid Edgar Thomson and Ed D. Washburn who were each qualified to chain and mark we viewed out and surveyed said road No 339 as proposed for in the petition for same, we find the road to be very much needed as an outlet for certain settlers, and of much use to the public generally. The road is located upon Section and Subdivisional Section lines, will be easy to open and keep in repair. We would therefore recommend that said road No 339 be declared a public highway.
