in Umatilla County Oregon.

I met Geo B. Clark, viewer at A.B. Reeks house Aug 5<sup>th</sup> 6:30 A.M. A.D. 1890 and administer to him the usual road viewers oath, Mr Clark having just returned from W.W. hospital says he is sick and unable to attend the survey in person - Word is brought that H.L. Gordon viewer is attending the bed side of a dangerously sick daughter and J.L. Killian viewer is not in the County, viewer Clark says the road is much needed and the petitioners would be greatly disappointed in delaying the survey, that there is no fighting the road, to his knowledge and that the viewers would be guided principally by Geo L. Stockman who prepared the petition and thinks I would better survey the road under direction of Mr Stockman and he in company with at least one of the viewers will go over the survey within five days and make their report to the Court, I therefore call Geo L. Stockman and Edgar Thomson to chain and mark and upon terminus for road No 344 which is set N 36° E 33' distant from cor claims to be NW cor Sec 2 T 5 CTR 32 E. Deed R 345 on north face and from said NW cor sec 2 Draw on line bet Secs 2 & 3  
90 Center of Ct. Juniper Canon 100' W. runs West Ascend  
100 Summit - Descend.
