Filed Notes of Road Survey No 343.

I met Boston Durr, Chas Schubert and Zeb Fawcett at Weston Depot, August 9th 1890, and administer to each, usual road viewers oath. We call Edgar Thomson and R. M. Powers to carry the chain and Thos. J. Price to mark, each of whom duly made oath according to law.

I set initial post on Road Survey No 343, 20 feet North of the center of Sec 16 S 4 NR 35 E and from said center of Section 16 I run along the north side of a rail fence and on a true line through center of said Section 16 Var. 20°-30' E East.

57 1/2 ft. Center of lane 40' wide course N 05°.

263 1/2 ft. Sec Cor. bet. Secs. 15 & 16 Tp 4 NR. 35 E.

Thence, on line through center Sec 15 in said Tp. East.

337 1/2 ft. Set angle post on line and turn.

582°-10' E Along line 100 ft. West of and parallel to O. R. & N. Cos. R. R. track

4950 ft. Set angle post on line, and turn,

526°-00' E Along line 100 ft. West of and parallel to said R. R. track,

4859 ft. Intersect the corporate line, N. bndy. of Weston, I set terminal post on line.

All of the posts are of the size and marked and set in mounds as required by law.
