Report of Viewers, Field Notes, and Plat of Survey of
Road No 371, Umatilla Co. Oregon,

commencing at a point where the Range Line
between Ranges 32nd & 33rd East of the Willamette Meridian
intersects the Base Line according to the United States
Government Survey, thence north along the Range
line to the North East corner of Section 13 in Town-
ship 2 North of Range 32 East of the Willamette Meridian,
thence west along the section line between the sections
12 and 13 in said Township and Range to the quarter (1/4)
section corner, corner between said sections 12 and 13
thence North to the legal center of said Section 12
in said Township and Range, thence west to the
quarter section corner, between sections 11 and 12
in said Township and Range, thence in a North-
westerly direction by the most practicable route to
the boundary line of the City of Pendleton, in
Umatilla County, Oregon.

In the matter of viewing, surveying and laying out
County Road No 371,

To the Honorable County Court, of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County,

We, the undersigned, the viewers heretofore appointed
to view and locate Road No. 371, submit the following
report: Pursuant to an order of the Honorable
Court, we met G. E. Maggamer, Deputy Surveyor, at
