Wednesday Aug. 26<sup>th</sup> 1891, I meet J. M. Watson &  
R. G. Thompson, who had by the Co. Clerk been sworn  
in as viewers on Road Survey 371.

We called Duke Frazier, Wm Turrell and Isaac W  
Kimball to chain and mark, and administered  
oath to each.

I set initial post on R. 371, 36° East of the intersection of  
the base line with the line bet. Ranges 32 & 33 E and  
with Engineers transit I run from said point of  
intersection, along said Range line
