Report of viewers, field notes and Plat of Road No 378  
in Unionville County, Oregon.

Commencing at the angle stake about 80 rods East of the center of Section 22 & 5 NW 33 E worn where road No. 328 turns West on the line between the Northeast and South east quarters of Section 22 & 5 NW 33 E worn, thence running in a northern direction on the most practicable route to secure a good road and good crossing over the O + W. I railroad tracks of the Y and Athena branch in the Vansycle Canyon where the wagon road crossings of said track is now located; thence along the east side of the right of way of the O + W. I railroad so as to there connect with the said County Road No 328.

To the Honorable County Court, of the State of Oregon, for Unionville County;
