Report of Viewers, field notes and Plat of Road No 379 in Umatilla County, Oregon,

commencing on County Road at SW corner of S.E. Clark's Homestead in section 22 Twp 55 R. 32 E. W.M., thence following the present traveled road to Lazinka's fence between sections 25 and 36 Twp 55 R. 32 E. W.M., thence east to the bluff of Cable Creek in sec 36 Twp 55 R. 32 E. W.M., thence southerly to the east line of said sec 36, thence south along said section line to the SE corner of said section 36. Thence west one half mile, thence by the most practical route to the one half mile stone on the south side of section 2 Twp 6 R. 32 E. W.M.

Said road to be forty feet wide.

To the Hon. County Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County,

In the matter of proposed Road No 379,

Meeting and organization of the viewers & Surveyor of said road.

We, the undersigned viewers and Surveyor of the above proposed road having met pursuant to appointment by your Hon. Court on this 1st day of Oct. 1891 & organized by qualifying for our several offices, do now in consequence of prior legal engagements adjourn to the 13th day of October 1891.

We your viewers and Surveyor having met as per adjournment and viewed and surveyed said road do now report that we employed as chain bearers R. E. Sturdwalt, James Brown, as markers C. Hale, as flagman Henry Lazinka, and as teamster Alex McKenzie and we now make the following report.

After examining the line and the ground we are satisfied that a good road can be made there at reasonable cost and we therefore recommend that a County road be established according to the accompanying survey and for the following reasons.

1st There is no road in that locality.

2^d There are residents there who need one.
