In the Matter Surveying Viewing and Laying  
Out County Road, No 427

Begun at a point 19 chains and 26 Links, South of the Corner of Section 27, 28, 33, & 36, in township three North of Range Thirty Three East of Willamette Meridian in Umatilla County, Oregon. And in the Centre of wagon Road No 368 at a post set, to still further designate the point of Beginning, and Running Hence West to the head of a Canyon on the North side of the farm formerly known as the Charles Brown farm, and now owned by Rigby & Son. Hence continuing down the said Canyon, which runs in a nearly westerly direction, through the land of Thomas Lorentz to the mouth of said Canyon to a point 125 ft North of the North East Corner of Thomas Lorentz's Cabin, which point is further designated by a post set in the ground. Continuing Hence from the post last described in a South Westerly direction, 250 feet and 3 inches to a point nearly in the Centre of Road No 370, which point of terminus is also designated by a post set in the ground. Said Road to be forty feet wide.

Viewers Report

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County.

We, the undersigned, the Viewers hereto fore appointed to view and locate Road No 427, submit the following report. Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court we met Jno. C. Arnold, County Surveyor at Court House Pendleton Or. on June 15<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1893, and were by him each, duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointments.

We called to our aid Edgar R. Thompson W.H. McCormack, Chainmen, Marker, who were by the Surveyor, each duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed and located said Road No 427 as specified in our order. We find the route practicable and there appears to be much of a demand for the road. We would therefore recommend that said Road No 427, be declared a public highway.
