

Surveyor appointed to survey said road, and after first taking an oath faithfully and impartially to discharge the duties of our appointment, we took to our assistance J. S. Richey and H. McRitner as chair bearers and as markers and proceeded to view, survey and lay out said road as prayed for in said petition, as near as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public, if such road shall be established and opened.

The said Jno. C. Arnold, Surveyor, surveyed said road under our directions, and the same was conspicuously marked throughout, the corners and distances thereon noted, and all trees on the line of said road were marked on each of the sides thereof corresponding with the direction of said road, with three notches cut through the bark and one inch into the wood, and all trees adjacent to the said line of said road were plainly blazed on the side facing said road. The beginning and termination of said road and the termination of each mile and intermediate points have been marked in the manner provided by law as will more fully appear by the certified return of said Surveyor of said Road, which is hereto attached and made a part of this report.

That in our opinion so much of said proposed road as shall be found to be wholly without the boundary lines of the town of Freewater Oregon, be established for the reason that said road, as proposed, is located upon good ground, and the said road operates as an outlet for seven families living in the vicinity of the same.

We would further report that so much of said proposed road as lies within the limits of said town of Freewater, is, also, upon good ground, but comprises a strip 30 feet wide along the south portion of certain private town lots in said town of Freewater, and on which there is a dwelling house.
