

Field notes of Road # 521.

Beginning at the SW corner of the SE 1/4 of Sec 7 Tp. 3 M. R 33 E W.M. where due north from initial point 20 feet I set stake. Marked R 521, 3 1/2 ft long, 18 inches in the ground. raised mound and dug trench thence West along line between Sections 7 and 18, 2590. feet, intersect East line of Section 7. From which point north 20 feet I set post 3 1/2 ft long 18 inches in ground raised mound and dug trench said post being marked. R. I. 521. C. E. Macomber, County Surveyor
