# MUTUAL ROAD AGREEMENT

This Agreement made this 6th day of April, 1955, by and between the Walla Walla Count Court, Walla Walla County, State of Washington, and the Umatilla County Court, Umatilla Count State of Oregon, hereinafter called the First Party and Second Party respectively;

Whereas, the First Party and the Second Party desire to cooperate for the mutual bene fit of both counties in an agreement concerning certain road sections along the County (State) line between the respective Counties and concerning other problems common to both Counties; Now, Therefore, in consideration of the several promises to be faithfully performed

by each, as hereafter set forth, the Parties do mutually agree as follows; that

#### Article 1:

The First Party shall be responsible for the reconstructing, draining, paving, and maintaining of all parts of the "State-Line" road running West from the old State Highway Ive Freewater, Oregon to College Place, Washington, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning on the North-South Centerline of Sec. 14, T6N, R35E., W.M., at the Oregon-Washington State line, and running thence in a Westerly direction along said state line six and one half  $(6\frac{1}{2})$  miles, more or less, to the West line of Sec. 14, T6N, R3LE, W.M., and also,

Beginning on the North-South Centerline of Sec. 16, T6N, R34E., W.M., at the Oregon Washington State line and running thence in a Westerly direction along said state line five (5) miles, more or less, to the West line of Sec. 15, T6N, R33E, N. ...

### Article 2:

The Second Party shall be responsible for the reconstructing, draining, paving, and maintaining of all parts of the "State-Line" road running East from the old State Highway from Freewater, Oregon to College Place, Washington, and more particularly described as follow t o wit:

Beginning on the North-South Centerline of Sec. 14, T6N, R35E, W.M., on the Oregon-Washington State line and running thence in an Easterly direction along said State line one and one-quarter (11) miles, more or less, to the North-South center-

line drawn through the West half of Sec. 13, T6N, R35E,W.M., and also, Beginning at the West line of Sec. 18, T6N, R36E,W.M. on the Oregon-Washington Stateline, and running thence in an Easterly direction along said State line two end three-quarters (2 3/4) miles, more or less, to the North-South Centerline drawn through the East half of Sec. 16, T6N, R36E,W.M. and also,

Beginning at the West line of Sec. 14, T6N, R36E, W.M. on the Oregon Washington State line and running thence in an Easterly direction along said State line one-mail (1/2) mile, more or less, to the North-South centerline of said Sec. 14,

maintain the Mill Creek road which runs South and East from Article 3: the Oregon-Washington State line through Sections 18, 19, 20, 21 and 22, T6N, R38E,W.M. we Party shall ordered by the Umatilla County Engineer at the costs as here inafter provided. It shall be the r esponsibility of the Umatilla County Engineer to determine when work shall be done and the t ime when said work shall be done but he shall be cognizant of the equipment and labor operation ing schedule of the Walla Walla County Road Department.

The First Party shall be responsible for the maintenance and all other necessary work on the Mormon Grade Road in Sec. 14, T6N, R37E.W.M. and the Pike's Peak Loop Road in Section 14, 23, 25, 26, 22, and 15, T6N, R37E,W.M. No compensation shall be granted from the Second Party to the First Party for the work outlined here in Article 4.

Both farties shall exchange equipment or services when necessary at an agreed upon Article 5: cost plus ten (10%) percent for overhead and operating expenses. As soon as this agreement s hall become legal, the Walla Walla County Engineer shall furnish to the Umatilla County and ineer a list of hourly rental rates for equipment and services as currently used by the Walla Walla County Road Department. This list shall be used by both farties as the cost basis for any future exchange of equipment or services. This list shall be subject to revision on Junuary 1 of each year during the life of this agreement because of any rising or lowering of c onstruction or maintenance costs during the preceding year.

Each farty shall furnish crushed rock material to the other Party when rock crushing operations are in progress along the State line, provided that advance notice as to quantity and time of need is given to the Party running said rock crushing operation, and further

ing expenses.

## Article 7:

This agreement shall remain in full force and effect until terminated by written stice of either Party. However, said termination notice shall be given not less than ninety (0) days before the effective termination date thereof.

#### Article 8:

As herein before stated each <sup>P</sup>arty shall pay the full costs of the reconstructing, ring, draining, and maintaining on the road sections herein assigned to them and nothing mained herein shall grant either <sup>P</sup>arty the right to regulate the work progress or work schedof the other <sup>P</sup>arty.
