Commencing at the South West corner of section 24, in Twp 5 North of Range 34 E.W.M. thence running east on the Section line on the South side of said Section 24, $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile more or less, to the South East corner of the South West quarter of the Southwest quarter of said section 24. thence north, $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile more or less, to the center of the Northwest quarter of said section 24. thence running in a northeasterly direction and along the east side of the gulch known as the Gey Springs gulch passing by the center of Section 13. in said Township 5 north of range 34 E.W.M. to the South East corner of the Northeast quarter of Section 12. in said Township and range thence running North. end on the East line of said section 12 about 500 yds more or less, to the north bank of Pine Creek. thence running in a northwesterly direction, end along the north bank of said Pine Creek, to its point of intersection with the County road known as the Gey Spring road. which point is near the center of Section One, in said Township and range. all situated in Umatilla County Oregon. the said road to be 40 feet wide;

and the said viewers having reported favorably, and recommended, the establishing of the same as a County road and the field notes and plat of Survey being duly on file and certified to by Surveyor appointed to Survey the same, it is therefore considered ordered and adjudged, by the Court that said road be established as a County road in accordance with the report of said viewers field notes and plat of Survey thereof be recorded as by law required and road ordered opened.

B. L. Simmons to W. Davis, and to Chris G. Watson, by reason of the location of the proposed County Road No. 518 through the same, assessing the damages to the lands of B. L. Simmons at \$25.00, to the lands of W. Davis, at \$15.00 to the lands of Chris G. Watson at \$5.00 and the matter coming up for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day said road being described as follows, to-wit, commencing at the Southeast corner of the SW 1/4 of Sec 15; in Tp. 6 N. of Range 35 E W M. running thence north through said section 15 about 53 1/2 rods chains to intersection of the line between the State of Oregon and the State of Washington.

And the said viewers having reported favorably, and recommended the establishing of the same as a County road and the field notes, and plat of survey, being duly on file, and certified to by Surveyor appointed to Survey the same

This therefore considered ordered and adjudged by the court, that said road be established as a County-road in accordance with the report of said viewers, field notes and plat of Survey thereof be recorded, as by law required, and road ordered opened. Then damages assessed by viewers are paid by the petitioners.

Pursuing no further business appearing, and the journal having been read aloud and signed therupon Court adjourned to meet tomorrow morning at 9 o'clock.
