Now on this day this matter coming on to be heard upon the bids offered by the Pendleton Tribune Company and The East Oregonian Publishing Company, said bids having been opened on the first day of the present term of this Court, to-wit: on Wednesday Nov. 4, 1896.

And it appearing to the Court that The East Oregonian Publishing Company has offered the lowest and most satisfactory bid to do the printing for Umatilla County, It is therefore ordered that the said East Oregonian Publishing Company be and he is hereby awarded the contract to do the printing for the said Umatilla County, according to the list made by the Clerk of this Court, for the period of one year, said Company to enter into an agreement in writing with the County of Umatilla, to be signed by the manager of said East Oregonian Company and by the Clerk of this Court on behalf of Umatilla County.

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers, E. J. Sommerville, Wm G. Bade and R. M. Dorothy heretofore appointed at the May 1896 Term of this Court, and which said report was resubmitted to the said Viewers at the September term of this Court, to view out and assess the damages to the lands of Kasson Smith by reason of the location of Road #479, assessing the damages at \$65.00 Said Road being described as follows: Commencing at the NW cor. of SW⁴ of the NW⁴, Sec 23, T⁶ N. R. 35 E. W. M. th. running E. through the center of the NW⁴ Sec 23 to center of N² Sec 23, T⁶ N. R. 35 E. W. M. and the matter coming up for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day of this Court, and the viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a County Road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same.

It is therefore considered, ordered and adjudged by the Court that the said road be established as a County Road in accordance with the report of said Viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required and road ordered opened when damages assessed by Viewers are paid by the petitioners.

Now there being no further business coming before the Court at this time and the Journal having been read, approved and signed, whereupon Court adjourned until Friday, Nov. 21st, 1896.
