Now on this day comes the report of J. L. Connell, J. B. Whitman and A. J. Cragg the viewers heretofore appointed at the July term 1892 of this court to view and determine how much less valuable the lands of Jacob Wheeler, George H. Wheeler, J. S. Wheeler and Sam B. Survey would be rendered by reason of the location of the above mentioned road as a County road for final hearing the same having been filed on Sept 6. 1892 it appearing from said report that said viewers met at the time and place appointed and were duly qualified before entering upon the discharge of their duties in behalf of the above mentioned land owners and it further appearing from said report that said viewers have estimated the damage to the lands of the above parties and find their land to be not damaged. But that the opening of said Road No 391 will have a tendency to enhance the value of the land belonging to the above mentioned parties. And it also appearing to the court that the viewers heretofore appointed to view and report upon the location of the above mentioned road duly made their report at the July term 1892 of this Court and that said viewers reported favorably and recommend the location of the same as a County road and the field notes and plat of said road being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same.

It is therefore ordered by the court that the report of said viewers be accepted and that the road be established in accordance with said report and that the report of said viewers field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required. That the road supervisor through whose district the said road passes be ordered to open the same to public use for a County road in and for Umatilla County Oregon
