WHEREAS, In accordance with ORS 368.206 the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners issued an order to survey and monument a portion of South Fork Walla Walla River Road, County Road No. 600, lying in Sections 9 and 10, Township 4 North, Range 37 E.W.M., and the access road running through Harris Park lying in Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 37 E.W.M., and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has found that the portion of the county road as traveled and used for ten (10) years or more does not match the existing road records and has recommended that the Board of Commissioners legalize the road as shown on the survey completed by the Public Works Department in November, 2002, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined it to be in the Public interest to re-classify the access road lying within Harris Park to a county road and extend County Road No. 600 to the easterly park boundary, and

WHEREAS, persons interested or concerned about this proposed relocation and legalization may examine said survey and other documents concerning this proposed action by contacting the Umatilla County Department of Public Works, 3920 Westgate, Pendleton, Oregon 97801. (541) 278-5424, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HERERBY ORDERED that a hearing is set for <u>February 5</u>, 2003, at <u>10:30</u> a.m. in Room 114 of the Umatilla County Courthouse, 216 S.E. Fourth Street, Pendleton, Oregon to hear public testimony both for and against the proposed legalization and re-classification and determine if South Fork Walla Walla River Road shall be legalized in its present location as traveled and used for ten (10) years or more and if the access road through Harris Park shall be re-classified to a county road.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that in accordance with ORS 368.206(1)(c), 368.406, 368.411, and 368.416 those persons whose property abuts said road relocation and re-classification shall be notified of this hearing by certified mail at least 30 days before the date of the hearing , notice of the hearing shall be posted in no less than three (3) public places no later than 20 days before the hearing , and

notice of the hearing shall be published in the East Oregonian once at least 20 days before the hearing and once within 10 days of the hearing.
