Now on this day comes the Report of the viewers W. D. Hunsford, J. S. McLeod and J. M. Ferguson, heretofore appointed at the November term, 1898, of this Court to view out and report upon the location of the above road as a County Road for final hearing, the same having been read upon a previous day of this term of this Court, to-wit: the January term, 1899, said road being described as follows: Commencing at the S.E. corner of Section 28, in Twp 3, N.R. 33 E.W.M. thence running North on the line between Sections 27 and 28. 59.50 chains, thence N. 58° 30' W. 7.65 chains, thence N. 76° 5' W. 3.97 chains, thence N. 63° 40' W. 8.38 chains, thence N. 46° 25' W. 4.07 chains, thence N. 36° W. 4.97 chains, thence N. 31° 30' W. 14.31 chains to a point in Lot No. 3 of the SE⁴ of Section 21, in Twp 3, N.R. 33 E.W.M. and N. 53° E. 11.42 chains distant from the S.W. corner of the SE⁴ of said Section 21 in Township 3 N. of R. 33 E.W.M. Said Road to be forty feet wide, and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a County road, and the field notes and plan of survey being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same.

Also comes the petition of George A. Bamhart, praying this Court that he be allowed the sum of \$1000 as damages in the opening of said road. It is therefore ordered by the Court that Bat Livermore, W. H. Jones and G. A. Hartman Sr. be and they are hereby appointed viewers to view out and estimate and assess as to the damages sustained by the establishing of the said proposed road as a county road to the lands of George A. Bamhart and that they meet at the Clerk's office in the Court House, in Pendleton Umatilla County, Oregon, on the 9th day of February, 1899, at the hour of 8 o'clock a.m. of said day, and that they report their doings at next regular term of this Court, to-wit: the March term, 1899, and that they duly qualify before entering upon the discharge of their doings in this behalf.

tion of the above road as a County road for final hearing, the same having been read upon a previous day of this Court, to-wit: the January term, 1899, said road being described as follows: Commencing at a point on present County road 40 rods north of the center Sec. 22 in Township 5 N.R. 36 E.W.M. thence southeasterly following the present traveled road up the South fork of Walla Walla river to a point 12 rods north of the N.E. corner of the S.E. 1/4 Sec. 9 in Township 4 N.R. 37 E.W.M. and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a County road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same and there being no remonstrance or claim for damages on file against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of said viewers be accepted and that the said road be established as a County Road in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the said report, field notes, and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required, and that the Supervisor through whose District said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.

no further business appearing and the Journal having been read, approved and signed, Whereupon Court adjourned until Monday, January 9th, 1899, at the hour of 9 o'clock a.m. of said day.
