Known as the Linton Mountain Road

Know All Men by These Presents, That Ralph Kinnear, and Myrtle Kinnear, his wife,

of the County of Umatilla in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One Dollar paid them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by them granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit:

A strip of ground 60 feet wide for highway purposes across the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of sec. 33 and the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 32 Twp. 5 N.R. 36 E.W.M., more particular described as beginning at a point 1300 feet S of and 550 feet East of the NE cor. of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 32 Twp. 5 N.R. 36 E.W.M., thence N 34° 37' W. 435 feet, thence N 35° 42' W. 360 feet thence N 52° 22' W. 1050 feet more or less to the E & W center line through section 32 Twp. 5 N.R. 36 E.W.M., and containing 2.5 acres more or less. Also beginning at a point 1287 feet E. of the SW cor. of the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 29 Twp. 5 N. R. 36 E.W.M., thence N 40° 42' W 1280 ft. thence S 87° 18' W 491 feet more or less to the W line of the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 29 Twp. 5 N. R. 36 E.W.M., and containing 2.4 acres more or less.
