HODGSON ROAD LEGALIZATION REPORT

HISTORY

Hodgson Road was established in the time period between 1880 and 1902 and is comprised of portions of three old roads. In 1880, Road No. 87 was established. It ran from the corner common to Sections 14, 15, 22, and 23 south along the section line to the Weston and Summerville Road (near present-day Highway 204). It was established at a width of 33 feet. In 1882, Peter Deardorff petitioned the County to move the road one rod (16 ½ feet) to the west for ½ mile from the corner common to Sections 22, 23, 26, and 27 to the ¼ corner common to Sections 26 and 27. The petition was granted and the road was established as Road No. 108. No right-of-way width was stated in the order establishing the road, though it did state that it was “duly opened a legal width”. In 1902, Road No. 533 ½ was established. It ran from the ¼ corner common to sections 26 and 27 south for approximately ¼ mile to near what is now Highway 204. Right-of-way width was 40 feet.

GENERAL

The majority of the road falls within the record rights-of-way well enough that no legalization needs to be done to correct the location of the road, though there is some question concerning the width of old Road No. 108. The southerly 1400 feet of the road does not match road records and needs to be legalized.

The existing connection with Highway 204 is in a very poor location for sight distance and is extremely steep. Jim and Melva Burns have granted a right-of-way easement across their property so that the intersection can be moved to a better location for sight distance and can be flattened out. The new road, which is approximately 800 feet long, will be given a new road number. The old (existing) intersection will be blocked. The existing right-of-way lying between the new road and Highway 204 should be left intact, as there are utilities installed in it, and the property owner on the west side of the road can still use it to access portions of his property if needed. At such time the property owners request that it be vacated, and the utility companies would have no objections, it could be vacated.

IMPACTS TO UTILITIES AND PROPERTY OWNERS

Utilities in the area include overhead power lines and buried telephone lines. No negative impact to utilities is anticipated. No negative impacts for property owners is anticipated, though there are some fences that are well within the right-of-way. At such time as any significant widening of the road is done, the fences may have to be moved.

STATUTES

ORS 368.201(3) provides a basis for the county governing body to initiate legalization proceedings if a road as traveled and used for 10 years or more does not conform to the location of a road described in county road records.

RECOMMENDATION

The Public Works Department recommends that the road be legalized as shown on the attached survey map and as described in the final order at the following widths: 33 feet from the corner common to Sections 14, 15, 22, and 23 south to the corner common to Sections 22, 23, 26, and 27 (Road No. 87); 60 feet from the corner common to Sections 22, 23, 26, and 27 south to the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner common to Sections 26 and 27 (Road No. 108); 40 feet from the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner common to Sections 26 and 27 south to Highway No. 204.

SURVEY NARRATIVE


THE PURPOSE OF THIS MAP IS TO SHOW THE LOCATION OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO BE OBTAINED FROM JAMES AND MELVA BURNS FOR A RE-ALIGNMENT OF HODSON ROAD IN ORDER TO PROVIDE A SAFER CONNECTION ONTO STATE HIGHWAY NO. 204. CONTROL POINTS WERE SET IN A PREVIOUS SURVEY AND A POINT-TO-POINT P-LINE TRAVERSE HAS RUN BETWEEN CONTROL POINTS "HOD2" AND "HOD4". IN ORDER TO DETERMINE THE NEW ALIGNMENT SHOWN, THE TRAVERSE WAS RUN WITH A TOPCON STS-300A ROBOTIC TOTAL STATION AND A LEICA TPS1100 TOTAL STATION. THE SURVEYOR USED A 100' GRID AND A 100' GRID TO OBTAIN AN APPROXIMATION OF TRUE bearings. ROTATE THESE SHOWN BY 0° 29' 50" COUNTERCLOCKWISE. DIVIDE DISTANCES BY THE PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED CONSIDERED SCALE FACTOR TO OBTAIN AN APPROXIMATION OF GROUND DISTANCES. SEE SURVEY NO. 08-473-C FOR ANY DETAILS NOT SHOWN.
