

THE RIGHT- OF-WAY CENTERLINE NEAR THE TERMINAL END OF ROAD 654


INSTRUMENTS USED WERE A WILD THE THEODOLITE AND A WILD DI-1000

THE SAME WIDTH AS ORIGINALLY DEDICATED.
