Now on this day comes the report of the viewers herefore appointed at the January 1891 Term of this court to view out and report upon the location of the above mentioned road as a bounty Road for final hearing, the same having been read upon a previous day of this term of this court to wit the March Term of 1891 and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a County Road and the field notes and plats of survey being duly on file and certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same and there being no remonstrance or claim for damages on file against said Road,

It is therefore ordered by the court that said Road be established as a bounty Road in accordance with the report of said viewers and that the report of said viewers, field notes, and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required and that the Supervisor through whose district said Road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a bounty Road.
