being no remonstrance or claim for damages on file against said road,
said road being described as follows: Commencing at the South East corner
of the North-East quarter of Section four, Township three North, Range
36 East Willamette Meridian; thence running North on Section line as
near as practical for one-half mile to the North-East corner of Section
four; thence running East for a distance of one mile on the most prac-
tical route and terminating at the North east corner of Section 3, all
in the same Township and Range. Said Road to be 40 feet wide.

be accepted and that the said road be established as a County Road in
