IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR THE COUNTY OF UMATILLA

In the matter of Locating, Establishing, altering, widening, straightening and changing of a County Road from a point on the Oregon-Washington paved highway near Athena, Oregon up Wild Horse Creek to the Quarter section corner common to Sections 3 and 10 in Township 4 North, Range 35 East, W.M., in the County of Umatilla, State: of Oregon, same to be know as County hoad No. 857.

Now on this day this matter coming on for hearing, the same having been publicly read the first time on September 2, 1925, and publicly read the second time on September 3, 1925, said Board finds that the owners of the land through which said road is to be laid out and established will be less valuable by reason of the establishing of said road as follows:

Let 5, Section 3 and Lot 9, Section 4, Township 3 N. Range 35 E.W.M., will be rendered less valuable by reason of the establishing of said road in the sum of \$200.00. In addition to the payment of said \$200.00, that the County Court cause to be erected along said road, a three wire fence, with cedar posts on each side of the right of way over and across said property. The Court further finds that Lot 6 of Section 3 Township 3 North Range 35 E., W.M., will be rendered less valuable in the sum of \$100.00, and in addition to the payment of said sum of \$100.00 the Court will cause to be erected a three wire fence with cedar posts on each side of the right of way over and across said property. All other lands over and across which said road passes will be rendered less valuable in the sum of nothing, save and except the SE/4 of Section 19, Tp. 4 North R. 35 E.W.M., on which damages were not assessed, for the reason that said matter is now in the Circuit Court for adjustment.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that said report of the County Hoad Viewers be approved; and that said road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County ; and that the same be finally surveyed and opened; and that the Clerk of this Court is hereby ordered and directed to issue warrants to the owners of the above described lands in payment of damages as above set forth.
