Now on this day the Viewers report having been read a second time in open court and the same being favorable for the location of the road, and a complaint having been filed by Madison Jones to have viewers appointed to assess the damages that said Jones may sustain by reason of the location of said road, It is now therefore ordered that A. G. Taber, J. B. Benson and J. M. Hicks, &c and are hereby appointed viewers, to meet at Madison Jones' on the 2^d day of August 1873, and after being sworn to discharge their duty faithfully and impartially, shall proceed and view said proposed road the whole distance through the premises of the complainant, and assess and determine how much less valuable such premises of the complainant would be rendered by the opening of said road, and report the same in writing to this court, at the September Term 1873.

In the matter of the location of County Road commencing
one mile south of Weston fence to Reservation at
Dr Perkins' on Wild Horse Creek.

Now on this day comes to a second reading the Viewers and Surveyor's report, and there being no protest on file against the location of said road, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that said road would be of public utility, It is now therefore ^{ordered} that said road be and is hereby declared a public highway strictly in accordance with the plat and field notes now on file.
