Beginning at a point on the West side of the rail road right of way, known as the Hunt line and as near as practicable to the center of section 35 T.5 N.R.34 E.W.M.and running in a southeasterly direction parallel to said right of way to a point on section line between sections 12 and 13 T. 4 N.R.34 E.W.M.; Thence across said right of way to the east side thereof; Thence continuing in a southeasterly direction and parallel to said right of way to a point on the quarter line of section 13 T 4 N.R.34 E.W.M.; then east on said quarter line to the Township line between Townships 4 and 4 of ranges 34 and 35 E.W.M.; Thence south on said township line one (1/2) half mile to the section corner, said road to be forty feet wide.
