Now on this day this matter cominG on feGularly to be heard upon the report of A.E.Perry, County Surveyor of Unatilla County, who was on the 8th day of May, 1919, ordered to post notices of the intention of this Court to vacate a County Road beeast a distance of one mile, more or leee, to the center of Sec. 34, Tp. 5 N.R. 34, E. .M.; thence South one-half mile to the township line between townships 4 North adn 5 NoRth; thence East along said township line a distance of one mile, more or less, to the West waif boundary of a County poul running North and South through the center of section 2; Tp. 4 North, Range 34, E.W.M.

And it appearing to the Court that due notice of the proceedings in this matter has been Given by the posting of three notices in the gicinity ofsaid road which is proposed to be vacated, and by the posting of a notice on the west door of the County court house in Pendleton, Oregon, the place of holding the County Court; that all of said notices were securely posted as by law required.

And the Coupt beind fully satisfied that the public will be benefitted by the vacation of said road; and that the said road is not Greatly needed as a part of the Jeneral road system of Umatilla County.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY OR ERED by the Court, that said(road as above described be, and thesame is, hereby vacated, and that the owners of the land adjacent to said road be, and the same are allowed andpermitted to close said road to the public.
