DEED GRANTING RIGHT OF WAY FOR ROAD

THIS INDENTURE made this 2. day of December, 1930, by May Grung Chief (PEMATALAKATS) an Indian woman, DEC 8-19 commonly and generally known as Mrs. Young Chief, surviving widow of Young Chief, deceased, Cayuse Indian Allotee No. 114, upon the Umatilla Indian Reservation in Umatilla County, State of Oregon, party of the first part, with the consent and approval of the Commissioner of Indian Affairs of the Department of the Interior of the United States of America, and Umatilla County, Oregon, a Municipal Corporation, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

That said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, paid to her by the said party of the second part, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant and convey unto the said party of the second part, a permanent right of way, thirty feet wide, for use as a public road across and over a strip of land in Umatilla County, State of Oregon, upon the Umatilla Indian Reservation, described as follows: 15 feet on each side of the center line

> Beginning at a point on the East Right of Way line of the Thornhollow Market Road, which point is south 14 degrees 30 min. east 245 feet from the Government Iron Witness corner set 20 feet East of the true corner at the center of Section 28, 0.3 cd Township 3, North Range 35 E.W.M. and running thence South 47 degrees 30 minutes East 155 feet; 2.35 cd thence south 70 degrees 30 minutes East 155 feet; 2.05 cd thence South 28 degrees 30 minutes East 550 feet; 8.33 cd. thence South 25 degrees 30 minutes East 665 feet 10.09 dd. to the North boundary line of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 28, in Township 3, North, Range 35, E.W.M.
