ABANDONMENT and RETENTION No. 328

ORIGINAL Return to Secretary

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WHEREAS, under the provisions of ORS 366.300, whenever the State Highway Commission relocates or realigns a state highway or any section thereof, and by reason of said relocation or realignment there is eliminated from the original highway portions thereof, the eliminated portions shall, if needed for the service of persons living thereon or communities served thereby, be maintained by the Commission at the State's expense or by the County, or by the State and County, on such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of ORS 373.010 whenever the route of any state highway passes through the corporate limits of any city of this state, the State Highway Commission shall select and designate the streets of the city over which the state highway shall be routed and may alter or change such routing when, in its opinion, the interest of the motoring public will be better served; and

WHEREAS, State has relocated and constructed the Athena-Blue Mountain Station Section of the Oregon-Washington Highway, State Primary Highway No. 8, in Umatilla County, the southwesterly terminus of which is at Highway Engineer's Station 846+00 and the northeasterly terminus of which is at Highway Engineer's Station 1200+00 on the said relocated highway; and

WHEREAS, due to the relocation of said section, portions of the former right of way are no longer needed for right of way purposes and may be eliminated as portions of the original Oregon-Washington Highway, State Primary Highway No. 8, which portions to be eliminated are hereinafter designated as Units A, C and E as shown colored in red; Unit B as shown colored in orange, and Unit D as shown colored in brown on the map attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and by this reference made a part hereof; and

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WHEREAS, the State Highway Commission, Umatilla County, and the Cities of Athena and Weston entered into an agreement dated December 12, 1960, relating to the elimination and disposition to be made of the aforesaid portions of the original Oregon-Washington Highway which are subject to elimination, and are hereinafter referred to as Units A, B, C, D and E; and

WHEREAS, said agreement provides that State, by resolution, upon completion of the said relocated section of said highway, shall formally eliminate said Units A, B, C, D and E as parts of the Oregon-Washington Highway, State Primary Highway No. 8, and the state highway system; and all right, title and interest which State has in Units A, C and E shall pass to and vest in County; and County shall accept all right, title and interest which State has in Units A, C and E and shall maintain Units A, C and E as parts of the county road system so long as needed for the service of persons living thereon and communities served thereby, and Unit B, being 3rd Street in the City of Athena, shall no longer be designated the route of the Oregon-Washington Highway in said city, and all jurisdiction and control which State has in Unit B shall be returned to City, and City shall resume complete maintenance of said Unit B as a city street. and Unit D, being Water Street in the City of Weston, shall no longer be designated the route of the Oregon-Washington Highway in said City, and all jurisdiction and control which State has in Unit D shall be returned to City, and City shall resume complete maintenance of said Unit D as a city street;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT HEREBY IS RESOLVED by this Commission as follows:

1. That, by reason of the relocation of the Athena-Blue Mountain Station Section of the Oregon-Washington Highway, State Primary Highway No. 8, in Umatilla County, portions of the former right of way of the Oregon-Washington Highway are no longer needed by the State of Oregon and are no longer required for part of the said new right of way of the said relocated Oregon-Washington Highway, which said portions to be eliminated are identified as Units A, B, C, D and E, as shown on the attached Exhibit "A" and described as follows:

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UNIT A:

Beginning at the Oregon-Washington Highway as relocated south of the City of Athena; thence northerly along said highway as formerly routed to the south city limits of Athena.

UNIT B:

Beginning on the Oregon-Washington Highway as formerly routed at the south city limits of Athena; thence northerly along said highway as formerly routed to a junction with the Athena-Holdman Highway at the intersection of Main and Third Streets in the City of Athena.

UNIT C:

Beginning at the Oregon-Washington Highway as relocated west of the City of Weston; thence easterly along said highway as formerly routed to the westerly city limits of the City of Weston.

UNIT D:

Beginning on the Oregon-Washington Highway as formerly routed at the westerly city limits of the City of Weston; thence easterly and northerly along said highway as formerly routed to the northerly city limits of the City of Weston.

UNIT E:

Beginning on the Oregon-Washington Highway as formerly routed at a junction with the existing Weston-Elgin Highway; thence northerly along the said highway as formerly routed to the Oregon-Washington Highway as relocated northeast of the City of Weston. LVN: bp 10/9/63

2. That, pursuant to said agreement entered into with Umatilla County and the Cities of Athena and Weston, dated December 12, 1960, Units A, C and E as heretofore described and as shown colored in red on the attached Exhibit "A", are hereby duly eliminated as part of the Oregon-Washington Highway, State Primary Highway No. 8, and all right, title and interest which State has in said Units A, C and E hereby pass to and vest in the said Umatilla County.

3. That, pursuant to the aforesaid agreement, Units B and D as heretofore described and as shown colored in orange and brown, respectively, on the attached Exhibit "A" are hereby eliminated from the route of the said Oregon-Washington Highway, State Primary Highway No. 8, in the Cities of Athena and Weston, and all jurisdiction and control which State has in said Unit B hereby pass to and vest in said City of Athena, and all jurisdiction and control which State has in said Unit D hereby pass to and vest in the said City of Weston.

4. That this resolution be entered in full in the minutes and records of this Highway Commission as Abandonment and Retention Resolution No. 378, this 22nd day of <u>November</u>, 1963, and the Secretary for the Commission is ordered to mail duplicate copies hereof to the Umatilla County Court and the City Recorder of the Cities of Athena and Weston.

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
