

In County Court July 10<sup>th</sup> 1883  
7<sup>th</sup> Judicial day Tuesday July 10<sup>th</sup>

In the matter of County Road, beginning  
at the road running up what is known  
as Ger King's Flat near the residence of  
J. W. Quinn, thence South about 8 rods  
to the Southwest Cor. of Sec 28, T5 N R  
34 E, thence West to what is known as  
Sand Hollow near the residence of George  
Kinney, thence in a North Westerly direction  
near the center line of Sec 30 T5 N R 34 E  
thence N. to the line of Sec 19 same Range  
thence W. about 70 rods. to center line of sec  
19, near the residence of E. Broughton,

Road No 153.

Now on this day comes the report of David Taylor and  
Henry Krebs, the viewers heretofore appointed at the April  
1883 term of this Court, to view out and report upon the location of  
the above mentioned road as a County Road for final hearing  
the same having been read on a previous day of this term, 16th July  
term 1883 and the said viewers having reported favorably and  
recommending the establishing of the same as a County Road; and  
the field notes and plat of survey of said road being duly on file  
and certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same and  
there being no remonstrance on file against said road,

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report  
of said viewers be accepted and that said road be established  
as a County Road, in accordance with said report, and that the  
report of said viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof  
be recorded as by law required, and that the Road Supervisors  
through whose district said road passes be directed to open the  
same for public use as a County Road,
