Now on this day comes the report of L.C. Penland, John Caplinger and Henry Bond the viewers heretofore appointed at the May Term 1890 of this court to view out and report upon the location of the above mentioned Road for final hearing the same having been read on a previous day of this term of this court July Term 1890 and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommending the establishing of the same as a County Road and the field notes and plat of survey of said Road being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same and there being no remonstrance on file against said Road.

It is therefore ordered by the court that the report of said viewers be accepted and that said Road be established in accordance with said report and that the report of said viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required and that the Road Supervisor through whose district said Road passes be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.
