Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of Geary Kimbrell, as County Surveyor, who was, by resolution duly adopted and entered on the 20th day of February, 1918, ordered by this Court to post notices of the intention of this Court to vacate a certain County Road, as follows: Commencing at the NE corner of Section 8, Township 3 North, Range 33 EWM and running thence South one mile and terminating at the SE corner of said Section 8, for the vacating of said road, for final hearing, and it duly appearing to the court that due notice of the pendency of such proceedings has been given by the posting of three notices in the vicinity of said road, and one on the bulletin board at the North entrance of the County Court House in Pendleton, Oregon, the place of holding the County Court, such notices all being posted as by law required, and the Court being further satisfied that the public will be benefited by the vacation of said road, and that said road is not needed as a part of the general road system of Umatilla County,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Court that said road be, and the same is hereby vacated.
