In the Matter of a County Road
from S.E. cor Sec 77 T 27 R 24 E to
Castle Rock on Columbia River

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers appointed at the April Term 1882 of this Court, to view out and locate upon the location of the above mentioned road as a County road for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day of this term of this court to wit; July Term 1882, and the viewers having reported favorably and recommending the establishing of the same as a County road, and there being no remonstrances on file against said road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said road be established as a county road in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the report of viewers, field notes, and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required.

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers appointed at the April Term 1882 of this Court, to view out and locate upon the location of the above mentioned road as a County road for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day of this term of this court to wit; July Term 1882, and the viewers having reported favorably and recommending the establishing of the same as a county road, and there being no remonstrances on file against said road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same.

It is therefore ordered by the court that said road be established as a county road conditioned that the Petitioners pay the cost of viewer and survey of same, in accordance with the report of said viewers and that the report of viewers, field notes, and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required, upon the satisfaction of said costs having been paid, being filed with the Clerk of this court.
