Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of A. E. Perry, County Suveyor of Umatilla County, Oregon, who was on the 4th day of September, 1919, ordered to post notices of the intention of this Court to vacate said road, beginning on the East and West line through sections 7 and 8, Township 3, North, Range 34 E.W.M., on the West line of the County road as the County road is now located, and thence West along the center line through the said center of section 7 to the west line of section 7, Township 3 North, Range 34 E.W.M.; thence West along the East and West center line through the center of Sections 12 and 11, township 3 North, Range 33 E.W.M., to the East line of the County Road as the same is now located through the center of section 11, Township 3, North Range 33, E.W.M.,

And it appearing to the Court that due notice of the intention of this Court in the matter has been Eiven by the posting of three notices in the vicinity of said road and by posting a notice on the bulletin board at the west door of the County Courthouse. at Fendleton, the place of holding said Court; and that all of said notices were posted as by law required, and the Court being fully satisfied that the public will be benefitted by the vacating of said road, and that the same is not greatly needed as a part of the general road system of Umatilla County.

IT IS THEREFORE, HEREBY, ORDERED by the Court that said

road, as above described, be, and the same is hereby, vacated and that the owners of said land adjacent to the said road, be and they are hereby allowed and permitted to close said road to the public. Dated November, 7, 1919.
