Now on this day comes the report of C. M^c. Morris and J. N. B. Gerking, heretofore appointed by this Court as viewers to view and assess the damage sustained to the lands of R. P. Warren and J. J. Raulstone by reason of the location of the above mentioned road as a County Road as prayed for in their petitions for damages, which said report awards and estimates the damage sustained to the lands of R. P. Warren and J. J. Raulstone by the location of said proposed County Road through the lands of R. P. Warren at the sum of \$125⁰⁰ and through the lands of J. J. Raulstone to the sum of \$50⁰⁰

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said road be established and located as a County Road in accordance with the report, field notes and plat of survey filed herein upon the payment by the Petitioners herein to said R. P. Warren of the sum of \$125⁰⁰ and to said J. J. Raulstone of the sum of \$50⁰⁰ as awarded them as damages by said viewers aforesaid, and that upon the satisfaction of said sums having been paid, being filed with the Clerk of this Court by the Petitioners, the Clerk of this Court will duly record said report, field notes and plat of survey as by law required and that the supervisors through whose District said road runs open the same for public use.
