RE: Road Vacation of Co. Rd. #892, Umatilla County, OR

ISSUE

Vacation of of a portion of Co. Rd. #892 located in Sec. 20, 18, 17, 16, 15, 14, and 13, T5N, R30, E.W.M., continuing into Sections 18, 17, 16, 9, and 10 T5N, R31, E.W.M., north of State Highway #37, Umatilla County, Oregon, approximately 15 miles north of Pendleton, OR.

FACTS AND FINDINGS

The petition has been filed with the prescribed fee of \$100.00.

The portion of Co. Rd. #892 is located in Sections 20, 18, 17, 16, 15, 14, T5N, R30 E.W.M., continuing into Sections 18, 17, 16, 9, and 10, T5n R31, E.W.M., the landowners, the petitioners, and the adjoining and abutting tax lots as described on the assessor's tax maps are attached in an exhibit. The Legal description of the proposed vacation is as follows:

That portion of County Road #892 beginning in Section 20, Township 5 North, Range 30 East of the Willamette Meridian at its junction with Oregon State Highway #37 and continuing Northerly and Easterly and ending at its junction with County Road #891 in Section 16, Township 5 North, Range 31 East of the Willamette Meridian.

The purpose for vacation is the public does not use this portion of road in general, as the county and state road systems have alternate roads for travel from one point to the other that are more efficient and direct than this portion of county road. Private property exists on both sides of the road, thus any member of the public using this road could be suspect of trespassing.
