KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the STATE OF OREGON, by and through its STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION, hereinafter called "Grantor", for the consideration of the sum of Fifty-meven and No/100 DOLLARS (\$57.00) hereby conveys unto UMATILLA COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, hereinafter called "Grantee", the following described property only so long as used for public purposes, to wit:

A parcel of land lying in the NW4SE4 of Section 25, Township 2 North, Range 33 East, W.M., Umatilla County, Oregon and being that property described in that deed to the State Highway Commission, recorded in Book 127, Page 417 of Umatilla County Record of Deeds, containing 3.8 acres, more or less.

This conveyance is made upon the express condition that the above-described land shall never be used for the placing or maintenance of any advertising sign, display or device, except such sign, display or device used to advertise the activities conducted on said land, and upon the further express condition that said land shall never be used as a place for the open storage or keeping of any debris, trash, waste or other unsightly materials.

In the event of the violation of the above condition, Grantor shall have the right, through its authorized officers, agents or employees, to enter upon said land and remove or destroy the offending sign, object or material without liability for damage or injury thereto, and to recover from Grantee, its successors and assigns, the cost of such removal or destruction.
