Now on this day comes the report of the viewers heretofore appointed at the Sept. Term 1891, of this court to view out and report upon the location of the above mentioned road as a County Road for final hearing, the same having been read upon a previous day of this term of this court, to wit - the November Term of 1891 and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommend the establishing of the same as a County Road and the field notes and plats of survey being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same and there being no remonstrance or claim for damages on file against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the court that said Road be established as a County Road in accordance with said report of said viewers and that the report of said viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required and that the Supervisor through whose District said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.
