In the matter of County Road  
The same being a change in Road No. 425  
Commencing at a point where College Street  
terminates on the boundary line of the city of  
Adams, thence following the foot of the hill in a  
Southwesterly direction and passing J. G. Adams'  
dwelling 50 ft on the S. side, thence passing the  
above named Adams' Windmill on the South  
side this portion of said Road being on the  
original survey of Road #425 thence bearing  
west over the point of hill some 200 ft from  
original survey thence S. W. across Wild Horse  
Creek to R. of W. of C. R. & K. R. R. thence down  
the West side of said R. R. to near 900 ft of S.  
C. allowing West line thence West across Wild  
Horse Creek and passing J. H. Ferguson's barn  
on the South side, thence in a S. westerly course to  
angle 15 in original survey of R #425 being about  
500 ft N. of the original survey, said road to be  
same width of original.

Now on this day comes the report of  
the viewers heretofore appointed at the January term, 1895, of  
this Court to view out and report upon the location of the  
above road as a County Road for final hearing, the  
same having been read upon a previous day of the term  
of this Court, to wit: the March term, 1895, and the  
said viewers having reported favorably and recommended  
the establishing of the same as a County road and the  
field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and  
certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the  
same, and there being no remonstrance or claim for  
damages on file against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said road  
be established as a County road in accordance with the  
report of said viewers, field notes and plat of survey therof,  
be recorded as by law required and that the Supervisor  
through whose district said road runs be directed to  
open the same for public use as a County Road.
