

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LEGALIZATION REPORT

Summary

A survey order dated April 3, 1996 was issued by the Board of Commissioners to survey and monument a portion of County Road #987 (Goad Road). The survey was completed by the Public Works Department in February, 1997 and a copy of the plat is attached. On February 27, 1997, notice of the public hearing was posted in 4 public places and all persons owning land abutting the proposed legalization were notified. Notice of the public hearing was published twice in the East Oregonian.

Facts and Findings

The survey of the road showed it to vary by up to 110 feet from its original dedicated position along the section line. The bridge (in the curved portion on the attached survey map) is approximately 90 feet from the section line. Road records show that the existing bridge was constructed in 1936, so the road has been more or less in its present location at least since then. The dedicated road shown on the attached original road survey plat and on the photos ran northerly to the Northeast Corner of Section 13 and then turned west. In 1913 a 40-foot wide road was deeded to the County from the beginning point shown on the legalization survey (Engineer's Station 100+00) around the hill to what is now the intersection of Trail Road and Goad Road near Interstate 84. This deeded road is what is now traveled from the beginning point of the legalization survey northerly to Trail road and its approximate location is shown on the photographs. That portion of the old dedicated road from the north end of the legalization survey to the Trail Road intersection has never been vacated.

Impacts to Utilities and Property Owners

All utilities in the area were located and kept within the surveyed right-of-way as much as possible.


Because the proposed legalized right-of-way highlighted in yellow is based on the road as it has existed for many years, no landowners would be affected adversely by the legalization and later vacation of dedicated right-of-way will benefit one landowner who has various improvements on the old right-of-way, which is highlighted in pink on the survey map.

Statutes


ORS 368.201(2)(a) provides a basis for legalizing a road due to alterations of a road over the years. ORS 368.201(3) provides for legalizing a road as traveled and used for 10 years or more if its location does not conform to the location described in County road records. Both of these statutes apply to this road.

Recommendation

Federal funding has been approved for the replacement of the bridge in the curve shown on the map. Preliminary plans are to build the new bridge and realign the road to the west to some degree, meaning some right-of-way will be required. Legalizing the road as shown highlighted in yellow will provide a good legal description of the existing road and a good base from which any needed right-of-way can be described. The Public Works Department recommends the road be legalized as shown on the survey map and described in the final order.



NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO MONUMENT A PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD

* 987, GOAD ROAD, FOR LEGALIZATION PURPOSES. THE ROAD RUNS MORE OR LESS
ALONG THE RANGE LINE BETWEEN 32 AND 33 EAST. THE ORIGINAL ROAD SURVEY
AND FIELD NOTES DO NOT MATCH THE PHYSICAL LOCATION OF THE ROAD BY APPROXIMATELY
THE DISTANCE THE CORNERS BETWEEN THE ADJACENT TOWNSHIPS ARE SHIFTED FROM
EACH OTHER, WHICH INDICATES THAT THE SURVEYOR OF THE ORIGINAL RIGHT OF WAY
WAS NOT AWARE OF THE SHIFTED CORNER CONDITION OR TIED THE ROAD INTO THE
WRONG CORNERS.

UMATILLA COUNTY MONUMENTATION SURVEY #92-92-C BY WELLS WAS USED AS THE BEARING BASE FOR THIS SURVEY. THE 1/16TH CORNER ON THE WEST LINE OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 18, T.2 N., R.33 E.W.M. AS SHOWN ON WELL'S SURVEY WAS IGNORED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING THE ALIGNMENT OF THIS PORTION OF THE ROAD AND THE SECTION LINE AS SHOWN ON THIS MAP IS THE LINE FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 13 TO THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13.

MONUMENTS WERE SET AT ALL CENTERLINE P.C.'S, P.T.'S, AND P.O.T.'S, EXCEPT AT 107+67.41 P.T. WHERE THE MONUMENT LOCATION FALLS ON THE EXISTING BRIDGE. THIS STATION WAS MONUMENTED ON THE RIGHT-OF-WAY LINES. OTHER RIGHT-OF-WAY MONUMENTS WERE NOT SET, AS THEIR LOCATIONS FELL EITHER IN CULTIVATED LAND OR WILL BE DESTROYED BY NEW BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION WHICH IS SCHEDULED FOR 1998.

ROAD ALIGNMENT WAS BASED ON TIES TO THE EXISTING ROAD FROM A CLOSED TRAVERSE THROUGH A SERIES OF ANGLE POINTS AND SECTION CORNER MONUMENTS AND WAS ADJUSTED BY THE COMPASS RULE. INSTRUMENTS USED WERE A WILD T-16 ONE MINUTE THEODOLITE AND A WILD DI-5 EDM.

COMMENCING AT A BRASS-CAPPED MONUMENT MARKING THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 13, T.2N., R.32 E.W.M.; THENCE S 0° 00° 38' W. 1783.95' ALONG THE EAST LINE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4.
